

Summer Registration is Coming!

Mark your calendars because registration for various programs are quickly approaching.

Our school age summer program begins on Monday, June 10 for all children first through fifth grade. We average about 30 children in our groups with 4 staff members. This program is held in Peavine Elementary School for 9 weeks during the summer. We have full time and part-time spaces available and plenty of space for all. Registration forms will be available in March.

Also, coming in March is registration for our Before and After School Program for the Fall of 2019. If your child will be in first through fifth grade at Peavine, Mamie Towles, Elmcrest, Grace Warner or Rollan Melton and you need after school care you will want to

register for this program. Space is very limited in this program, especially transportation, so be ready to register as soon as possible. **Information will be posted in time for everyone to participate. We offer part-time A.M.'s and P.M.'s for 2019.**

Registration will also take place for the Preschool program for both Summer and Fall, 2019. Again, space is limited as we try to keep our groups at 10. A non-refundable deposit of half the first week is required to hold your child's place. Payments will be automatically withdrawn when forms are turned into the office. Questions?
