- The fiscal years ends Friday, Dec. 29.
   Payment for 12/26-12/29 will be drawn on 12/26 so that it falls in the 2018 tax year.
- 1/1/19-1/12/19 will be deducted on 1/2/19 and every two weeks after that. Then we

will be on our normal two week schedule.

#### Let It Snow!


Please be aware of the following in the event of a major snowfall:
