Your child needs to stay home if...

...they woke in the morning with their eye "glued" shut. (possibly pink eye)

...they are running a temperature of 100 or higher, without medication.

...they have had diarrhea or vomiting within the last 24 hours.

...they have an unidentifiable rash on any part of their body. (possibly contagious)

...they have a yellow/golden, oozing sore around mouth or nose. (possibly impetigo)

...they are congested with cold, coughing <u>continually</u> and have green nasal discharge.

...they complain of a sore throat, cannot swallow and have swollen glands.

...they have lice or nits in their hair, even after treatment with medicated shampoo.

...they have been sent home from elementary school due to illness.

<u>Please note that depending upon a child's symptoms</u> <u>they will need to remain home from 24-48 hours</u> <u>after all symptoms have disappeared.</u>
