#### Sick Child

It is imperative that if your child shows any sign of ANY illness, you keep them at home for at least 48 hours. If we end up having to send your child home, they will need to be out for 14 days and at the end of those 14 days, you will need to provide a negative Covid-19 test. Also, we will roll down your emergency pick up list until we can get ahold of someone to ensure your child is picked up as soon as possible. We can not wait to have them picked up during Covid, they need to be picked up immediately in order to be in compliance with the Health Department. If your child looks unwell during our morning screening, we will ask that they not stay. No exceptions. Thank you for your understanding.

#### Be Ready to Show Your ID

Please be aware that staff are advised to check the IDs of every person coming to the center in the evening to take a child home. Every person taking a child from the center needs to be on your pick-up list and needs to be able to present a current ID since you will not able to sign in or out on the kiosk. Please call the office to check if your emergency list is current.
